Monitor Shutdown Challenge Winners

During the month of April, a random and unannounced audit was conducted by the Janitorial Supervisor, and the three winning companies listed above had the lowest percentage of computer monitors left on and were declared the winners.

The Monitor Shutdown Challenge was a campaign to encourage tenants to turn off their computer monitors every evening, with the hopes of turning this action into a sustained behaviour. Turning off your computer monitors every evening is a simple action that can save a great deal of energy. For every LCD monitor that isn't turned off nightly, 22 kWh/month (or approximately \$29/year) is wasted, and for every CRT monitor that isn't turned off nightly, 67 kWh/month (or approximately \$90/year) is wasted!

We would like to thank all of the companies that participated in the challenge for their consideration and participation, and hope that everyone will continue to turn off their monitors and encourage co-workers to do the same, as we strive to make the properties the greenest tenant community!
